No-Cost Lead Hazard Remediation & Abatement for Newark Homeowners

Was your home built before 1978? Are you concerned about existing lead-based paint in your home? You could be eligible for to receive no-cost lead remediation or abatement. Apply now to Habitat for Humanity of Greater Newark's Critical Repair and Healthy Homes Initiative to receive no-cost lead remediation or abatement.

Requirements

- Your household income is within the low-tomoderate income limits (see table).
- You own a 1 to 4 unit residential home built before 1978.
- The property is structurally sound.
- Notice of Violation from local Health Department (lead abatement only).

What Help Is Provided?

- Preliminary lead testing to determine if lead is present on painted surfaces.
- Lead Inspection/Risk Assessment of your home.
- Remediation: minimizing lead-based paint hazards through renovation, repair and painting.
- Abatement: safe removal or encapsulation of lead hazards so they no longer pose a threat to resident health (HUD program).

Repair Your Home

This program's goal is to identify, remediate, and/or abate lead-based paint hazards to prevent elevated blood lead levels in residents of Newark, NJ. Applicants must live in the city of Newark, NJ, not earn more than 80% of area median income (see table below) to qualify, and must attend a mandatory orientation.
